

Wisconsin Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Exam Information

****Exam Date: April 9, 2011**

****Registration Deadline: 90 days prior to the exam (January 7, 2011)**

Registration Instructions:

1. The process is two steps. You will register for the exam through one website, and then schedule and pay for the exam through another.
2. Begin by creating an account online with the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) by visiting:

3. While registering for the exam, you might be asked “Have you been authorized to sit for this exam?” If you are asked this question, answer “yes.”
4. Complete the registration process and make note of your NCEES ID number.
5. Schedule and pay the exam fee to Professional Credential Services (PCS). You will need your NCEES ID number to do this. Start by visiting the PCS Website and clicking on “Applicant Information” on the far left.

6. Click the “Fundamentals of Engineering (FE)” link under the “Wisconsin” heading
7. Click the “NCEES Registration and EES Scheduling Information” link to be taken to the relevant directions. Please note that there are slightly different instructions here for first-time exam takers versus re-exam candidates.
8. Complete the registration process online, by phone, or by mail. The registration deadline is **January 7, 2011**. Your registration must be **complete** by this deadline.
