

Prior to defending their dissertation, Human Factors PhD students must complete at least six seminar/special topics courses at the 700 level or above totaling a minimum of 12 credits; at least three totaling at least 6 credits of these must be in the Human Factors and Ergonomics area. Students may use 700+ level seminar courses also as breadth courses if not Human Factors focused towards requirements. Other courses may qualify. Students may submit courses to the HFE Area group for consideration.
