THE MOON CAMERA BILL FREEMAN

My attempts to photograph the Earth from space using the moon as a camera, and several computational imaging projects resulting from those attempts.

William T. Freeman shared the 2020 Break-through Prize in Physics for a consulting role with the Event Horizon Telescope collaboration, which reconstructed the first image of a black hole. He is the Thomas and Gerd Perkins Professor of Electrical Engineering and Computer Science (EECS) at MIT and a member of the Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence Laboratory (CSAIL).
